

John Ellard Gore.

We deeply regret to state that Mr. Gore, an original Member of our Association and a Fellow of the Royal Astronomical Society for the last 32 years, was killed in a street accident in Dublin, on the 18th of July. Born on the 1st of June 1845, he held for nine years a post in the Government engineering department in the Punjab, and his first publication was an

account of some southern stellar objects observed by himself. Later, besides some original work on variable stars and orbits of stellar binaries, he was the author of a large number of well-known excellent popular works on astronomy, several of which must be familiar to many of our readers; he also translated Flammarion's *Astronomie Populaire* into English.—W. T. L.
