

THE LATE MR. BRUCE H. CLARKE.—One of the silent members of the Association; who to the best of our knowledge was never able to attend any of the meetings of the Association, died on April 16, at the early age of 28. An invalid from childhood, he was never able to go either to school or college, and active observing was beyond his physical powers. Nevertheless the Association was the poorer in losing him. He joined the Solar Section of the Association in order to help the Director in examining the distribution of faculæ as given in the Greenwich Photoheliographic Results, and to the Editor of the *Journal* he was of very great assistance, seeking out himself interesting and important papers in various publications and writing notes and abstracts of them. He did what he could.

Mr. Clarke was elected a Member of the Association on January 26, 1910.
