

THE LATE MR. CHARLES LEESON PRINCE. — On April 23rd, after a long illness, Mr. C. Leeson Prince died, in the 78th year of his age. He was educated for the medical profession, but did not practice, and early took a deep interest in astronomy and meteorology, to both of which he made several valuable contributions. He was elected a Fellow of the Royal Astronomical Society in 1857, and in 1872 he removed from Uckfield to Crowborough which is one of the best astronomically situated positions in the United Kingdom. His best known writings are perhaps connected with climatic and weather conditions, and in this connexion he issued in 1895 a literal translation of the "Phenomena," and "Prognostica" of Aratus. He was an original Member of this Association.
