Ladislaus Weinek.

The death of Prof. L. Weinek, Director of the Observatory

at Prague, in the 66th year of his age, is announced. Prof. Weinek was a well-known selenographer, and both by his own sketches of lunar formations, and, more recently, by his study of the lunar photographs taken at the Lick and Paris Observatories, did much to advance our knowledge of this branch of Astronomy. He was particularly successful in producing enlargements of certain formations included in the photographs, which brought to light many formerly unrecorded features. He was an original member of our Association.
